ARPA-H Accelerates the Entire Health Ecosystem




Our Goal: Meet People Where They Are

ARPA-H was launched to improve health outcomes for all Americans. *Congress said we had to have 3 geographic sites.*

ARPA-H must meet people where they are, whether across communities and geographies. ARPA-H has a responsibility for all Americans, especially those that have been the hardest to reach.

ARPA-H is responsible for delivering transformational health solutions. This means making sure our programs transition into viable approved products and translate into practice.



ARPANET-H: Bridging Innovation and Customers Nationwide

1. Rapid Other Transaction Master Vehicle.

- For proposers: B2B style, simple templated process for project awards
- For the USG: increases R&D throughput by outsourcing some high effort grunt work

2. Health Ecosystem Convening Mechanism.

- Pull together collection of entities that don't typically work closely with one another. Many would not normally engage with USG.

3. Instant IDIQ-style Catalog of Resources.

- No additional contract awards needed. Events, design tools, collaboration space.

The Investor Catalyst Hub, part of the Advanced Research Projects Agency for Health (ARPA-H), connects researchers, entrepreneurs, and investors to accelerate the development of innovative healthcare solutions.

Spoke Benefits



Spokes are eligible to **apply for funding** to support Investor Catalyst activities, projects, immersive experiences, and initiatives.



Spokes are able to use **flexible contracting vehicles** resulting in award execution significantly faster than traditional government contracts.



Spoke membership provides **networking opportunities** with consortium members (industry, academia, nonprofits, and other health ecosystem stakeholders), government (ARPA-H and other federal agencies) and other strategic stakeholders at annual membership meetings, conferences, and forums.



Spokes have opportunities to provide **feedback and input** into ARPA-H challenge areas, problem identification, and priorities.



Spokes will also be able to access and contribute to an open **library of resources** and public goods that draw on the insights from ARPANET-H activities.

Immersive Experiences

- In-person, on-site visits to a spoke by ARPA-H program managers
- Provide authentic, unique exposure to situations outside of their traditional environments

The opportunity to apply to become a spoke is open to all institutions/organizations with strengths that align with the ARPA-H research focus areas:

- Health Science Futures: Expanding what is technically possible
- Proactive Health: Keeping people from being patients
- Scalable Solutions: Reaching everyone quickly
- Resilient Systems: Building integrated healthcare systems



Consortium Membership Agreement

A Consortium Membership Agreement (CMA) governs the rights and the obligations of Consortium Members as related to a Consortium. Consortium Members sign a CMA.
